Recommendation: Hybrid format, taking into account the following:

- 1. The recommended maximum capacity of the largest Conference room at UNON, room 2, is 168 participants
- 2. All the 36 Member Countries of the Executive Board as well as delegations from State Members of the United Nations and United Nations Specialized Agencies that have Permanent and Observer Missions to UN-Habitat based in Nairobi should participate in-person in a 1+1 representation format
- 3. All other members of such delegations of the Nairobi based Missions, all other delegations from State Members of the United Nations, any other member of a United Nations specialized agency, and intergovernmental organizations and non-governmental organizations in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council or accredited to the UN-Habitat Assembly and not based in Nairobi should participate online
