### I. Organization

The United Nations Human Settlements Programme, UN-Habitat, is the agency for Human settlements. It is mandated by the UN General Assembly to promote socially and environmentally sustainable towns and cities with the goal of providing adequate shelter for all. The work described here is located in the Urban Economy Branch of UN-Habitat.

# II. Background

## **ASUD Programme**

Urbanization is rapidly changing the nature of human society. The fast-paced growth of cities, especially in Asia and Africa, promises to continue for the next 30 years. Cities hold a plethora of opportunities for the diverse populations that inhabit them. However, rapid urbanization has often been characterized by the marginalization of the poor. If left unguided and without support from the public sector, the urbanization process will result into slum formation, unplanned and spontaneous land occupation, congestion and urban inefficiencies of various kinds.

The Achieving Sustainable Urban Development Programme (ASUD) represents for UN-Habitat a pilot experience at country level to address the urbanization process from a new paradigm. The new vision makes a shift in focus and incorporates three essential elements into a new working methodology: Urban Legislation, Urban Design, and Urban Finance, as a three legged strategy in advancing sustainable urbanization (Annex 1).

# II. Tasks and responsibilities

Under the overall supervision of the Habitat Programme Manager in Bogotá Colombia, and the Urban Economy Branch Consultant from UN Habitat Headquarters, the consultant in Urban Economy and Finance will be responsible for the following duties:

Developing a realistic and implementable financial plan is crucial to the successful implementation of urban plans. The work described below addresses Financial Analysis and Modelling components in the context of ASUD Colombia.

The consultant will be responsible for gathering data and information necessary for construction of financial models showing public expenditures and revenues related to urban

plans, in addition to helping local governments select an appropriate combination of financing mechanisms for each planned extension or revitalization area. Primary tasks will include the following:

- 1. Produce report on trends analysis and baseline data on municipal finance systems, including but not limited to the following:
  - a. Current revenue and trend by source, collection rate, and performance
  - b. Current budget structure and trend
  - c. Potential revenue enhancement including expansion of existing sources and possible new sources
  - d. Access to external financing by source and amount
  - e. Current expenditures (capital and operational) by major component
  - f. Capacity for financial management including available technology and any ongoing initiatives for improvement.
- 2. Work with the urban planners to understand expected land uses projected and new infrastructure needed in each concept plan scenario.
- 3. Estimate public expenditures on infrastructure, and services (including both capital and ongoing expenditures) associated with plan implementation.
- 4. Identify relevant taxes and fees generated by anticipated land uses and calculate projected revenue arising from these sources.
- 5. Compile a Financial Assessment Report summarizing revenues and expenditures associated with extension concept plans, including net present value and return on investment.
- 6. Evaluate the appropriateness of a variety of financing mechanisms for PCE concept plans, drawing upon the expertise of international UN-Habitat consultants.
- 7. Assist local governments in selecting the preferred combination of financing mechanisms and preparing business plans for PCEs.


