Implementation plan - Criteria

- Mandate Is the deliverable mandated by the Economic and Social Council, General Assembly, the Governing Council of UN-Habitat and the Habitat Assembly?
- UN-Habitat added value How is UN-Habitat potential offer/support of greater value than that offered by other stakeholders (in the country)?
- Convergence with governments' demand Is there a political will and commitment to address the challenge?
- Transformational effect What is the potential to bring change and positively influence other development priorities to help countries progress towards the greatest possible number of SDGs/ Targets?



Implementation plan - Criteria

- Reach/scope How many people are affected? What is the magnitude of the challenge? What is the geographical coverage?
- LNOB What is the potential positive effect of working on this challenge for the groups left behind or at risk of being left behind?
- Time sensitivity What is the consequence (both short term and long term) of not acting fast on the challenge?
