	For participants to benefit from interpretation in the event of a virtual session, the session should be web streamed in all six languages. Conference Services would need to create a dedicated Youtube channel for the six languages.	
	The provision of interpretation services will depend a lot on the participants end connection speed and equipment readiness. Interpreters will need to hear very clearly all the speakers to be able to translate accurately. The interpreters may stop at any given time should the quality of the interpretation be affected. Moreover, the possibility of interruption of interpretation is considerably high.
