

WUF10 OBJECTIVES

The United Nations General Assembly in its resolution 69/226 recognizes the WUF as **the** foremost global arena for interaction among policymakers, local government leaders, nongovernmental organisations and expert practitioners of **sustainable urban development** and human settlements.

- Raise awareness of sustainable urbanisation among stakeholders and constituencies, including the general public
- Improve the collective knowledge of sustainable urbanisation through inclusive open debates, sharing of lessons learned and the exchange of best practices and good policies
- Increase coordination and cooperation within the UN System and with different stakeholders and constituencies for an effective implementation of the New Urban Agenda and the urban dimension of the SDGs
- 4. Provide **substantive** and **strategic inputs** from multilateral organisations, national and subnational governments and stakeholders into the **reporting** of the implementation of the New Urban Agenda

VOICES AT WUF10

- Prepared for hand-sanitizers & ambulance at ADNEC































WUF 10 AT A GLANCE

7,726 (80%) were internationals coming from all regions of the world (169 countries)




























Participation by Partner-type
































Participation by Age










Participation by Region




HIGH LEVEL PARTICIPATION

- Nearly 100 Mayors and Governors




