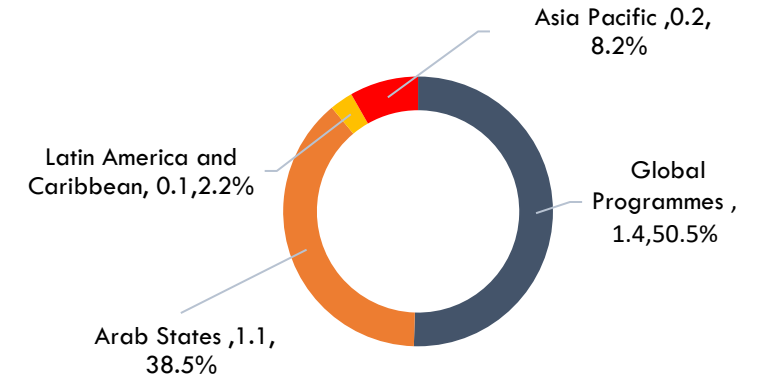

## Allocation of income acquired in 2021 to UN-Habitat implementing regions

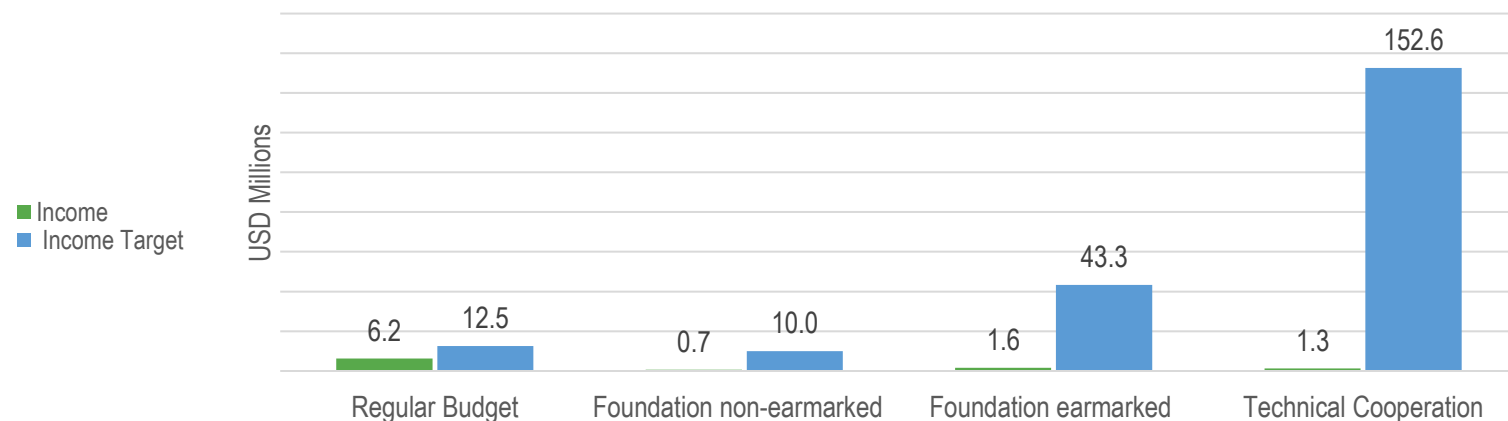
