RECOMMENDATION:

Transform urban weak spots, both systemic and area based to improve resilience to future shocks.

RECOMMENDATION:

Promote redistributive measures towards a rights-based allocation of urban space and resources — land, housing, water, energy, public spaces and digital infrastructure

RECOMMENDATION:

Territorial or spatial governance approaches to neighbourhoods, cities and regions, that are articulated into integrated responses give better possibilities to address the health risks
