1. BACKGROUND AND CONTEXT - CPR HIGH LEVEL MID TERM REVIEW 💓





a. General Assembly Resolutions.

- 1.General Assembly resolution 72/226 which called for establishment by the Chair of the Committee of Permanent Representatives to UN-Habitat(CPR) of an open-ended Working Group in Nairobi to examine different options for strengthening Member States' oversight of UN-Habitat.
- **2.General Assembly document 73/726** which is the "Report on the work of the Openended Working Group established by the Chair of the CPR with the findings and recommendations of the open ended working group.
- 3.General Assembly resolution 73/239 which welcomed and endorsed document 73/726 on findings and recommendations of the open-ended Working Group established by the CPR Chair, with specific decisions on the "Governance of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat)".
- 4.UN-Habitat Assembly decision 1/1 adopting the Rules of Procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly.
- 5. Rule 23 of the Rules of procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly is specifically on the Committee of Permanent Representatives as an intersessional organ of the UN-Habitat Assembly

b. Rules of Procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly-Rule 23 and Rule 29.

Rule 23.1. "The Committee of Permanent Representatives is composed of all Permanent Representatives of States Members of the United Nations and members of the United Nations specialized agencies that are accredited to UN-Habitat".

23. 2. "The Committee of Permanent Representatives shall convene, in an openended manner, twice every four years: once prior to the UN-Habitat Assembly, in preparation for that session, and once for a high-level midterm review. If necessary to efficiently implement its mandate to prepare the next session of the Assembly, the Committee may, on a basis of consensus, establish subcommittees".

Rule 29. "The rules of procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to all intersessional organs that do not have their own rules of procedure...."

2. NOTIFICATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND DOCUMENTATION





a. Notification of the Executive Director.

The Notification of the Executive Director was sent on 18 May 2021 in all UN official languages to all Member States informing of the agenda and date of the meeting.

The Notification communicated the following key elements of the Bureau's recommendations:

- 1. The meeting be **held three days from 29 June to 1 July 2021** possibly in a hybrid format should the prevailing COVID-19 situation permit.
- 2. The **provisional agenda** for the CPR high level midterm review as recommended by the Bureau on 8 December and 24 February 2021 with a highlight of the key issues to be discussed.
- 3. The format of the meeting being possibly a hybrid meeting combing in person participation and online participation should the global pandemic situation permit.

On 24 February and 28 April 2021, the Bureau recommended that the meeting be held in a hybrid format if possible. On 8 June 2021, however, the Bureau considered the possibility for both hybrid and fully online options. A final recommendation by the Bureau on the format will be made on 17 June 2021 and communicated.

- iii. The Dialogue duration would be **90 minutes** as part of plenary on day 2 which is 30 June 2021.

- 4. Recommendation on WUF 10 outcome and WUF 11 preparations in line with GC resolution 26/6 on the World urban Forum.
- 5. Recommendation on the dates and agenda of the second session of the UN-Habitat Assembly and the dates and agenda for the next Open-Ended CPR meeting.
- 6. Recommendations to the Secretariat on work programme adjustments and reprioritization, for the remaining years of the Strategic Plan, based on gaps analysis.
