EGYPT

> Land Readjustment as a tool for effective detailed planning In Quena.

Completion of the **vision of the New Sharm El Sheikh** converting it into a Green Touristic global destination, with a diversified economic base.

➢New urban upgrading approach developed & the first testing phase launched in 4 cities in Damietta.

Opening of the last River Bank Filtration (RBF) unit in Luxor in partnership with Coca-Cola (300k beneficiaries. Total project beneficiaries over 2 million)

Bike sharing introduced and under implementation under the **revitalization of the of down** town Cairo under the PM's leadership.

A transport regulatory unit created in the "New Community Authority" and fully operational.
 Completion of the City of Ras El Bar Plan, introducing principles of walkability, cycling, inclusive public spaces...etc.

> Luxor City is confirmed to host the global observance for the World Cities Day 2021



SUDAN

- "Transition to Sustainable Peace and Social Cohesion and Peaceful Co-existence in Blue Nile State (Norway Funded)": addressing the root causes of the conflict, provide basic services, secure land tenure and property rights in addition to livelihood opportunities for youth and women.
- "Emergency Support to IDP Returns in Eid Elfursan Locality, South Darfur State (Japan Funded)": IDPs sustainable returns and ensure human security through securing land rights, self-help construction and improvement of basic services and public facilities by producing Stabilized Soil Block (SSB).
- "UNAMID-UNCT joint activities on enhancing "Rule of Law" and "Durable Solutions": training on land rights and securing land rights for IDPs in five Darfur States.



LIBYA

- Working with other UN Agencies to identify to support the newly formed transition government
- > The 6 cities profiles undertaken are being disseminated through the Libya data portal
- An assessment of the land administration and land rights situation is ongoing; the report will define entry points to improve and reform the land sector, a key element of urban reconstruction and peacebuilding
- A Roundtable with key government institutions and other land stakeholders is planned for the 29 & 30 June; key themes are land-based financing, land markets, land taxation and affordable housing.
- Collaboration with other UN agencies on the work against forced eviction is ongoing.



TUNISIA

- > National Urban Policy (NUP) adopted by the Tunisian Government;
- A study on the Social expulsion finalized
- SDG11 Data document for Tunisia prepared
- Rehabilitation of the 3 Homeless Centers of the country, in the context of COVID -19
- Design competition « A Roof for Dignity », for the Homeless with the National School of Architecture ;
- Social inclusion of Migrants strengthened in La Marsa, through joint artistic activities
- Waste Wise Cities tool launched with the Municipality of Sousse in preparation of the TICAD
 8 and integration of the Sousse Municipality to the ACCPlatform ;
- In preparation of the Food system Summit (Sept 2021), organization with FAO and the Tunis Municipality, of the Dialogue "Towards healthy, resilient and inclusive urban food systems for the city of Tunis"
