# | Expectations for the Regional Group Consultation

- Priorities of Member States regarding the further implementation of the Strategic Plan 2020-2023 in the LAC Region
- Feedback from Member States on the implementation and impact of UN-Habitat programmes and activities in the LAC Region
- Dialogue with Member States about UN-Habitat's financial situation and the resource mobilization strategy
- Submissions of national reports of the New Urban Agenda (NUA) as input to the Quadrennial report of the Secretary General, in preparation for the High Level Meeting of the General Assembly on the progress of implementation of the NUA
- Activities by Member States related to Urban October, including World Habitat Day and World Cities Day



# | Some strategic areas to advance the Strategic Plan in LAC

- 1. **Housing:** Promoting of Regional Public Goods (Ex. UHPH Platform – Urban Housing Practitioners Hub to support member states’ efforts to generate adequate housing.
- 2. **Urban integration of migrants and refugees:** Partnership with UNHCR-IOM to support cities in the integration of migrants/refugees with hosting communities under the principles of the NUA and SDGs. Key programme advancing with support of EU. Third phase in design (5 years, 50 municipalities, 50 M USD)
- 3. **Cities Investment Facilities:** Based on SDG Cities and CIF, developing a multi-stakeholders facility to generate a pipeline of well-structured urban integrated programmes to boost investment in LAC cities with SDG/Social impact (Ex. SE Mexico, Bolivia, Brazil, Central America)



# | Expectations for 2<sup>nd</sup> Session of the Executive Board for 2021

- Approval of Work Programme and Budget for 2022
- Discussion on the recalibration of the Strategic Plan following the first meeting of the High Level Mid Term Review of the CPR
- Dialogue with Member States about the financial situation, the financial plan and resource mobilization strategy for the remaining part of the Strategic Plan period
- Building consensus on the transition to the proposed new strategic planning cycle 2026-2029
- Feedback of Member States regarding normative and operational activities of UN-Habitat, including global initiatives, flagship programmes, regional and country programmes
- Enhanced engagement of Member States in championing selected initiatives
