- The Notification of the Executive Director was sent on 6 October 2022 to all member states informing of the agenda and date of the second session of the Executive Board for the year 2022 as required by Rule 3 of the rules of procedure.

2.EXPECTATIONS ON THE 2022 SECOND SESSION OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD





- 1. The work programme and budget for the year 2023 is expected to be considered and possibly approved by the Executive Board at its 2022 second session. The scalability model requested by the Board at the 2022 first session has been availed as one of pre-session documents to support the discussions by the Board.
- 2. The agenda item related to the **Normative and Operational activities** of UN-Habitat will focus on the thematic areas of:
 - i)UN-Habitat's contribution, experiences and added value in urban crisis situations, and
 - ii) the implementation of the five flagship programmes under the strategic plan 2020-2023.

These are:

- Flagship programme 1:inclusive, vibrant neighbourhoods and communities
- Flagship programme 2:people-centred smart cities;
- Flagship programme 3:rise up: resilient settlements for the urban poor;
- Flagship programme 4:inclusive cities: enhancing the positive impact of urban migration;
- Flagship programme 5: Sustainable Development Goals cities (SDG cities)

At the recommended of the Bureau, the Executive Director has invited partners to compliment presentations related to the Normative and Operational activities of UN-Habitat.

2.EXPECTATIONS ON THE 2022 SECOND SESSION OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD





- 3.The session will be an opportunity to share the outcome and value of the High-level meeting of the General Assembly to review the implementation of the New Urban Agenda under held in April 2022 under the leadership of the President of the 76th session of the General Assembly, for Sustainable urbanization and for UN-Habitat's work.
- 4. The Executive Board will be briefed on the preparations and roadmap for the second session of UN-Habitat Assembly to be held in June 2023. With the guidance of the Joint Bureaux of the Governing Bodies of UN-Habitat the theme of the second session of the Assembly is "Inclusive, reinvigorated and effective multilateralism for a better urban future: Achieving the SDGs in times of global crises."
- 5.The Executive Board will be briefed by the **UN Joint Inspection Unit (JIU) on its report on the review of the management and administration of UN-Habitat**. As an outcome, the Executive Board may make recommendations based on the report including for consideration by the UN-Habitat Assembly
