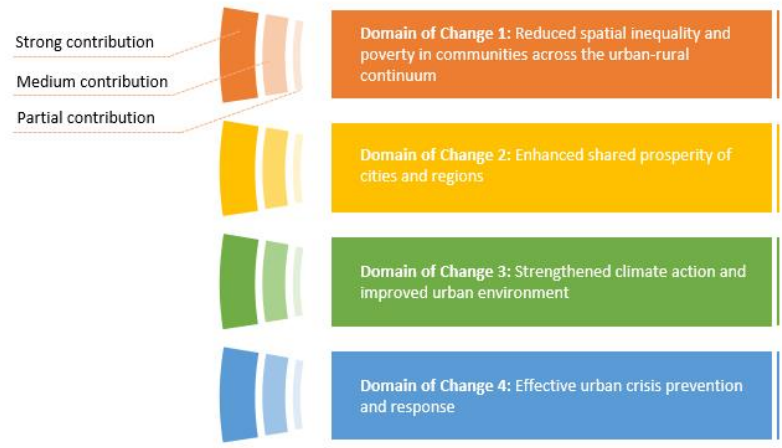

Recalibrating the Strategic Plan 2020-2025

A **three-lens approach** enables UN-Habitat to rebalance investment and establish a better connection to knowledge, assets and capacities through an integrated way of working.

1:
Responding to new vulnerabilities and risks in cities

2:
Adapting the function and form of cities to respond to current and future crises

3:
Supporting long-term socioeconomic urban recovery

The approach will guide further analysis of the Programme's normative and operational portfolio and its contribution to the strategic plan.
