### Draft technical inputs from the secretariat for the proposed draft outcomes for consideration by the Executive Board at its first session of 2023

This version represents the conclusions of the discussions held on Wednesday 8 march 2023 on draft Decisions 2023/[A], 2023/[B] and 2023/[C].

Draft decision 2023/[A]: Financial status of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme, update on the financial reserve, updated scalability model for the non-earmarked budget of the Habitat and Human Settlements Foundation, analysis of the risks related to the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation and overview of earmarked private sector contribution agreements

#### (a) Financial status of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

#### The Executive Board

1. *Takes note of* the report of the Executive Director on the interim financial status of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme as at 31 December 2022;<sup>1</sup> Ad Ref 8 March 2023

2. *Takes note of* the report of the Executive Director on the scalability model for the nonearmarked Foundation budget,<sup>2</sup> subject to various level funding up to \$12 million, and *requests* the Executive Director to report back on the scalability model at the first session of the Executive Board of 2024; [suggestion to extend scalability model to WPB 2024] {CMR+}

## (b) Analysis of the risks related to the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation and overview of earmarked private sector contribution agreements

5. *Recalls* paragraph 21 of decision 2022/5 [which requests the Executive Director to obtain an analysis by the United Nations of the reputational risk associated with potential investment by the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation and to present to the Executive Board, at its first session of 2023, a report detailing the findings of the risk analysis and providing information, in the interim, prior to entering into them, on any non-earmarked private sector agreements entered into on behalf of UN-Habitat, including with the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation, and also requests an overview of earmarked private sector contribution agreements that are currently in force] {CMR+}, [takes note of] the analysis of the risk related to the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation<sup>4</sup> and the overview of earmarked private sector contribution agreements,<sup>5</sup> [[recommends] that the Executive Director, on behalf of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme, enter into a contribution agreement with the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation, and [reiterates] its request that the Executive Director present a risk analysis prior to entering into any non-earmarked private sector agreements.]{USA and FRA reserve}

7. *Recalls* paragraph 16 of decision 2022/5, requests the ad hoc working group on programmatic, budgetary and administrative matters to continue its discussions on the non-earmarked budget of the Habitat and Human Settlements Foundation for 2024, and requests the Executive Director to finalize a draft annual work programme and budget for 2024 based on feedback from the Committee for Programme and Coordination and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and to present that work programme and budget for further consideration by the Executive Board at its third session of 2023. [7 bis. *Recalls* paragraph 17 of decision 2022/6, *takes note* of the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on the programme budget implications of this decision, and *decides* to approve the supplementary budget for 2023 of \$303 600 including \$209 900 in staff costs for the establishment of one P3, one P2 and 2 local level posts and \$93 700 in non-staff costs spread equally across sub-programmes 1 to 4.] {CMR+, NGA+, BRA+, FRA-, USA-, DEU-}
