IMPORTANCE OF THE UNITED NATIONS HABITAT ASSEMBLY AND HIGH-LEVEL PARTICIPATION

- The United Nations Habitat Assembly is the prime legislative platform for global urban policy making
- The Assembly takes place once every four years
- Expected high-level representation at the Ministerial level for the 193 State Members of the United Nations, and for substantive representation at the session.
- UN-Habitat also expects **participation at highest level of Government** as has been in the past.
- Letters inviting Ministers of Foreign Affairs have been transmitted.
- Letters inviting line Ministries have been transmitted.



NOTIFICATION FOR THE SECOND SESSION OF THE UN-HABITAT ASSEMBLY.

- Notification for the second session of the Assembly was shared on 31 December 2022 in all UN official languages
- The Notification contained the dates which are 5 to 9 June 2023 and the provisional Agenda for the session. It also contained the special theme of the session and other preliminary information.



THEME OF THE SECOND SESSION OF THE UN-HABITAT ASSEMBLY.

The theme of the second session of the UN-Habitat Assembly is

"A sustainable urban future through inclusive and effective multilateralism: Achieving the SDGs in times of global crises"

The report of the Executive Director on the special theme will help to structure **the Dialogue on the special theme** during the Assembly and possibly inform **the Ministerial Declaration** as a key outcome of the Assembly at its second session.

- 5 June 2023 before the opening plenary at 10am: deadline for receipt of Credentials in line with the rules of procedure.

 - 5. Climate change and resilience.
 - 6. Early Warning, Rapid Response and Post Conflict and disaster Reconstruction Framework.
 - 7. Urban planning and Sustainable Urban Infrastructure.

 - 8. Decision on extension of the current Strategic Plan until 2025.
 - 9. Decision on the next session of the UN-Habitat Assembly aligned with the QCPR and the next Strategic Plan.
 - 10. Decision on the stakeholder engagement policy.
 - 11. Resolutions related to the report of the JIU on administrative and management review of UN-Habitat, especially as related to governance.
 - 12. Election of 36 new Members of the Executive Board.
 - 13. Election of a new President and Bureau of the UN-Habitat Assembly.
 - 14. Financing and monitoring mechanism for resolutions.



EXPECTED STRUCTURE OF THE SECOND SESSION OF THE UN-HABITAT ASSEMBLY.

☐ Member States are encouraged to participate fully in the five-day session. Detailed discussions are expected under each item of the provisional Agenda ☐ High-level segment of the Assembly is designated for 5 and 6 June 2023 ☐ The High-level segment is expected to include the presence and participation of Heads of State, and in addition, there is a possibility for the First Ladies (and possibly First Gentlemen) roundtable to take place within the days assigned for high level segment ☐ Member States will have the opportunity to deliver National Statements — most likely delivered at the Ministerial level. ☐ Dialogue on the special theme of the second session of the United Nations Habitat Assembly with expected participation of Governments, Partners and Stakeholders ☐ It is expected that various partners and stakeholders, notably subnational governments, parliamentarians and non-governmental organizations, will convene their own informal consultations, events and activities prior to and during the session ☐ The Bureau is continuously firming up the detailed organisation of work of the session
