2.EXPECTATIONS ON THE 2023 FIRST SESSION OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD



- The financial status of UN-Habitat: The non-earmarked Foundation is in a historically healthy position THE NEW THE NEW and the current operation is based on the \$3 million budget approved by the Board for 2023. UN-Habitat welcomes guidance with respect to its finances, including on the financial reserve and on the principles of the scalability model.
- 2. The findings of the analysis of the reputational risks related to **the Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation** as requested by the Executive Board. Our expectation is that the Executive Board may issue further guidance to enable UN-Habitat to enter into a contribution agreement with Sustainable Human Settlements Foundation and receive the donation from the Foundation.
- 3. The agenda item related to the **Normative and Operational activities** of UN-Habitat will focus on the need for and the possible benefits of the development of the model of Sustainable Development Goals Cities certification. The the Executive Board, may make related decisions including those that may enable UN-Habitat to rally Governments, United Nations system, the private sector and other actors to jointly further develop the Sustainable Development Goals Cities certification model.
- 4. Following the briefing **the upcoming second session of United Nations Habitat Assembly**, the Executive Board may consider and recommend to the Assembly a draft stakeholder engagement policy for further consideration. The Executive Board may also make additional recommendations for the consideration by the Assembly at its second session.
