Wastewater is the forgotten part of the water cycle. What is out of sight is out of mind and is not given the attention it warrants for health, environment, or justice reasons. Pollution continues unabated, and we can only account for 20% of the total wastewater produced globally.

Due to the ever-worsening climate crisis, more communities have to deal with the consequences of floods or droughts each year. Outdated wastewater treatment systems have never been designed to deal with these extremes. As a result, floods create health hazards and pollution, while in periods of drought, valuable 'waste' water is wasted since it cannot be treated and reused.

If we are serious in adopting the much-needed global transformation toward a circular and resilient economy, wastewater management needs to be at the centre of any development policy. The situation is critical in a range of member states at different stages in development.

In this event, we will take a fresh look at SDG 6.3.1, which all our countries agreed to seven years ago. Let us align our ideas and approaches to support better more inclusive wastewater policies and practices in the global efforts towards reaching the Agenda 2030.
