IMPORTANCE OF THE UNITED NATIONS HABITAT ASSEMBLY AND HIGH-LEVEL PARTICIPATION

- ■The United Nations Habitat Assembly is the prime legislative platform for global urban policy making.
- ■The Assembly takes place once every four years.
- Expected high-level representation at the
 Ministerial level for the 193 Member States of the
 United Nations, and for substantive representation at the session.
- ■UN-Habitat also expects participation at highest level of Government.
- Invitations have been sent to Ministers of Foreign

 Affairs and to line Ministries.






NOTIFICATION FOR THE SECOND SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS HABITAT ASSEMBLY

THEME OF THE SECOND SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS HABITAT ASSEMBLY

The theme of the second session of the UN Habitat Assembly is:

"A sustainable urban future through inclusive and effective multilateralism: Achieving the SDGs in times of global crises"

5 key actions areas:

1. Universal access to adequate housing	4. Localisation of the SDGs and multi-level governance
2. Urban climate action and environmental protection	5. Prosperity and finance
3. Urban crisis recovery	

The <u>report</u> of the Executive Director on the special theme will help to structure **the Dialogue on the special theme** and inform **the Ministerial Declaration** as a key outcome of the Assembly at its second session.

OVERVIEW OF THE DETAILED PROGRAMME – KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- 1. Member States are encouraged to **participate fully in** the five-day session. Detailed discussions are expected **under each item** of the provisional Agenda.
- **2. High-level segment** of the Assembly is designated for 5 and 6 June 2023.
- 3. The High-level segment is expected to include the presence and participation of Heads of State on the first day, and First Ladies on the second day.
- 4. Member States will have the opportunity to **deliver National Statements**, mostly delivered at the Ministerial level and by Heads of delegations.
- 5. Dialogue on the special theme of the second session of the United Nations Habitat Assembly with expected participation of Governments, Partners and Stakeholders.
- 6. Various **partners and stakeholders**, notably subnational governments, parliamentarians and non-governmental organizations, will convene their own informal consultations, **events and activities** prior to and during the session.


