2. CONTINUATION OF DISCUSSION CYCLE OF ELECTION OF THE OFFICES OF THE GOVERNING BODIES WITH THE QCPR



Based on informal Consultations so far, there seems to be emerging consensus on the new the following:

- i. The current Strategic plan of UN-Habitat should be extended until 2025 to cover the period 2020 to 2025.
- ii. The upcoming second session of the United Nations Habitat Assembly to be held from 5 to 9 June 2023 should be adjourned to resume in 2025 in order to allow for the alignment of UN-Habitat Planning Cycles with the QCPR, at the earliest opportunity.
- iii. That the resumed session of the Assembly would approve a new strategic plan for the period 2026 to 2029 to be prepared by the Executive Board.
- iv. That the election of offices of the Governing Bodies should also align with planning cycles of UN-Habitat and the CPR.
