5. DISCUSSION AND GUIDANCE ON RATIONALIZING PRE-SESSION DOCUMENTS

- (a). Communication from the UNON Division of Conference Services
 - i. DCS will service **the three-day session comprising of 6 meetings** (two per day), with interpretation and report writing.
 - ii. DCS will process <u>not more than 90 pages</u> of documents through editing and translation into the six UN official languages. This includes pre-session, insession and post session documents.
 - iii. That the limit of 90pages will not include the 2024 draft work programme and budget which DCS will process as well.
 - iv. DCS does **not have the staff capacity** to process any other document beyond the limits they have provided.
 - v. If we outsource this function beyond the 90 pages, it will cost about 183 USD per page.
