

Strengthening and Expanding UN-Habitat's Presence and Support to Member States in the Arab Region

LIBYA

UN-Habitat is looking forward to finalizing the Host Country Agreement in Libya following the recent mission in August 2023.

PALESTINE

UN-Habitat and the Government of Palestine, represented by the Ministry of Local Government (MoLG), signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the period 2023-2026.

KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA

UN-Habitat and the Kingdom of Saudi of Arabia signed the Host Country Agreement to fortify the ongoing collaboration on urban development





STRATEGIC UPDATES

Localizing SDGs in Arab Cities; Voluntary Local Reviews launched in Agadir and Amman

- ROAS is providing tools and technical guidance to support national and local governments implement SDGs and report on their progress.
- ROAS is establishing the Local2030 Cairo Hub which will offer capacity building and support for SDG localization in the region.
- The (VLRs) provide an assessment of the state of implementation of the SDGs at the local level and a solid basis to advance their implementation.
- Following the launch of Amman, Jordan VLR in 2022, the VLR for Agadir, Morocco was launched in November 2023.
- Three more cities (Hay Ennour, Tunisia; Irbid, Jordan; and Ramallah, Palestine) are currently finalizing their VLRs with support from UN-Habitat.




STRATEGIC UPDATES

Support to National Urban Policies

- UN-Habitat supported the development of national urban policies as an overarching coordinating framework to deal with the most pressing issues related to rapid urban development in several countries in the Arab region including Egypt, Lebanon, Jordan, Sudan and Palestine.
- The National Urban Policy for Egypt and Palestine were recently endorsed by the respective Cabinets, providing a reference for the implementation of public interventions in urban areas.
- Iraq has recently kickstarted the process of developing its NUP with support from UN-Habitat.



- ROAS Staffing requirements for the upcoming period:
 - SHSO RO P5 total approximately USD250,000
 - HSO RO P4 total approximately USD220,000
 - PMO RO P3 total approximately USD200,000
