## Outcomes of the second Ministerial Meeting on Urbanization and Climate Change at COP28

**Dubai, United Arab Emirates, 5 December 2023** — On 6 December, the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) – the United Nations entity responsible for sustainable urban development – along with representatives of national and local governments, will hold a press briefing to present the agreed outcomes of the second Ministerial Meeting on Urbanization and Climate Change.

Ministers of housing, urban development, environment, and finance, local and regional leaders, financial institutions, and non-government stakeholders are meeting at COP28 to highlight the critical importance of adaptation finance for urban areas and ensure cities are equipped to address the climate crisis.

Currently, as much as 90 per cent of cities are threatened by rising sea levels and storms, and their residents are exposed to temperatures 10 degrees higher than their counterparts in rural areas. Finance for adaptation remains a bottleneck, with only 21 per cent of climate finance allocated to adaptation and resilience, and only 10 per cent reaching the local level.
