STRATEGIC PLAN 2020-2025



II UN Habitat Assembly approved Strategic Plan 2020-2023 in May 2019 and **II UN Habitat Assembly** extended to 2025 in order to align the planning cycle of UN-Habitat with the **Quadrennial Comprehensive Policy Review (QCPR)**

- **Defines** UN-Habitat's medium- to long-term goals, as well as the resources plans to achieve them
- And **strongly contributes** to the implementation and monitoring of the SDGs and the New Urban Agenda.

The Strategic Plan was developed :

- Based on UN-Habitat's mandate;
- Using empirical data gathered from research to identify emerging issues;
- With the inputs of Member States through the Governing Bodies and the demand at country level;
- Using information from the sessions of the World Urban Forum emanating from governments and partners.
