




Expense mix in 2023






Financial positions: 31 December 2023






Financial positions: 31 March 2024









Foundation: contribution pattern and donor base

...the level of contributions is in line with prior years






Foundation: donors by income level


While contributions are proportional to donor economy...

Percentage of contributions 2020-23



Number of donors 2020-23

















Member State desirable ranges






Regional breakdown of staff
