


Ongoing Registration updates



Registrations





Registrations per organization type

- **32 LDCs** have confirmed attendance with Note Verbale. (71%)
- 59 Ministers and Deputy Ministers have confirmed attendance
- 156 confirmed **speakers** and 13 **moderators** (at the main sessions)

Forecast

18,000

12,409 7,615

International registered participants

Currently we have **7,615 international** participants registered.

We expect the percentage of internationals attending WUF to be around the ranges of 20% to 30% of the total.

Our current forecast is approx.18,000 participants.

Currently 94% of registered participants mention they will attend in person/this is over 9,800 people, with 600 online participation.

For reference, **WUF11** had **7,000** in person participants.









Events by region




Events by Categories



 - Post-event: reviews the WUF Report






Social media advocacy




