





Ongoing Registration updates

Currently we have **6,700 international** participants registered.

We expect the percentage of internationals attending WUF to be around the ranges of 20% to 30% of the total.

Our current forecast is approx.18,000 participants.


Currently **94**% of registered participants mention they will attend **in person**/ this is over **9,800** people, with **600** online participation.


For reference, WUF11 had 7,000 in person participants.

Overview

- 44 of 193 countries have confirmed officially with Note Verbale (22.8%)
- 14 Non-LDC's out of 149 countries, have confirmed (9.3%)
- **30 out of 45 LDC** have confirmed with Note Verbale. (67%)
- 91 confirmed speakers.

Ministers


- 23 Ministers have confirmed attendance (4 are female and 19 male)


Slot allocation

Partners received an email on **05 September** to select their preferred time slots through GEMS.


Editing Events

Events by region




Events by Categories

 - Post-event: reviews the WUF Report










Social media advocacy

Internal Info Sessions


Promoting WUF12 registration and participation scheduled week of 23 Sep

Engagements with host country

- 1) WUF coordination **advance team** currently on mission to work closely with government counterparts on backstopping and final steps.
- Coordination of all aspects through the National Coordinator on course; venue preparations, protocol, travel, accommodation, etc.
- 3) Massive media campaign activities by UN-Habitat and host country to mobilize in-country participants
- 4) UN-Habitat engaging with Egypt country office to undertake **urban** campaigns and Cairo Urban Week as advocacy towards WUF12
