Resumed second session of the United Nations Habitat Assembly of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

Nairobi, 29 and 30 May 2025

Notification by the Executive Director

I. General information for Member States

1. On 20 December 2018, the General Assembly of the United Nations, in its resolution 73/239, decided to dissolve the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) and to replace it with a United Nations Habitat Assembly of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat Assembly) with universal membership.
2. In accordance with resolution 73/239, the first session of the UN-Habitat Assembly was held from 27 to 31 May 2019. During that first session, the Assembly adopted its rules of procedure.
3. Rule 2 of the rules of procedure provides that the UN-Habitat Assembly, having a universal governmental membership, will convene in Nairobi for a five-day period every four years to, among other functions, identify key issues and areas of focus for the normative and policy work of UN-Habitat; adopt resolutions, declarations, recommendations, formal decisions, reports and other documents pertaining to strategic vision and political guidance, in accordance with its mandate; and examine and approve the UN-Habitat strategic plan, to be prepared by the Executive Board.
4. Accordingly, the second session of the UN-Habitat Assembly was held from 5 to 9 June 2023. During that session, the Assembly decided, in accordance with rule 9 of the rules of procedure, to adjourn its second regular session and to resume the session for a duration of two days, on 29 and 30 May 2025, in order to align the planning cycle of UN-Habitat with the quadrennial comprehensive policy review of operational activities for the development of the United Nations system.
5. At its adjourned second session, the UN-Habitat Assembly adopted the following outcomes:

II. Dates, venue, provisional agenda and participation

7. Pursuant to rule 2 of the rules of procedure and decision 2/2 of the UN-Habitat Assembly, the present notification serves to inform Member States that the resumed second session of the Assembly will be held at the headquarters of UN-Habitat in Nairobi on 29 and 30 May 2025.

8. The provisional agenda of the resumed second session, as set out in document HSP/HA.2/12, is presented in annex I to the present notification.

9. The provisional agenda, which is based on decision 2/2 of the UN-Habitat Assembly, was reviewed by the Bureau of the Committee of Permanent Representatives to UN-Habitat at its meeting of 2 September 2024 and recommended to the Bureau of the UN-Habitat Assembly for its consideration.

10. The substantive documents for the session will be issued by 17 April 2025, at least 42 days in advance of the session, in accordance with paragraph 3 of rule 30 of the rules of procedure.

11. It is anticipated that the session will be opened at 10 a.m. on Thursday, 29 May 2025.

12. Pursuant to the relevant rules of procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly, the following are expected to participate in the sessions of the Assembly:

- (a) All States Members of the United Nations;
- (b) The chairs of the intersessional organs of the UN-Habitat Assembly, as appropriate;
- (c) United Nations specialized agencies, related organizations and other United Nations bodies;
- (d) The entities, intergovernmental organizations and other entities referred to in rule 66;
- (e) The organizations referred to in rules 67 and 68 and other relevant stakeholders.

13. The present notification is therefore specifically addressed to the above-mentioned entities, in line with rule 8 of the rules of procedure.

III. Key issues to be discussed

14. The main focus of the resumed second session is the completion of the unfinished business of the adjourned second session held in June 2023. The key issues therefore include:

- (a) Consideration and possible approval of the strategic plan of UN-Habitat for the period 2026–2029;
- (b) Consideration and possible approval of the draft international guidelines on people-centred smart cities, in line with resolution 2/1 of the UN-Habitat Assembly;
- (c) Consideration and possible adoption of the draft stakeholder engagement policy of UN-Habitat, in line with decision 2/4 of the UN-Habitat Assembly;

- (d) Election of the 36 members of the Executive Board of UN-Habitat, to serve for a period of four years;
- (e) Election of the Bureau of the UN-Habitat Assembly, to serve for a period of four years.

IV. Bureau

15. In accordance with rule 18 of the rules of procedure, the Bureau of the UN-Habitat Assembly will comprise a president, three vice-presidents and a rapporteur elected by rotation among the regional groups of States, with due regard for the principle of equitable geographical distribution.

16. In accordance with decision 2/3 of the UN-Habitat Assembly, the officers of the Bureau elected during the first session of the UN-Habitat Assembly, in 2019, are to remain in office until the final meeting of the resumed regular second session of the UN-Habitat Assembly.

A. Composition of the current Bureau

17. The composition of the current Bureau, which will preside over the resumed second session, is as follows:

- President: Mexico (Latin American and Caribbean States)
- Vice-Presidents: Ghana (African States)
Poland (Eastern European States)
Germany (Western European and other States)
- Rapporteur: China (Asia-Pacific States)

B. Composition of the next Bureau

18. The geographical distribution of the next Bureau, to be elected at the final meeting of the resumed second session to serve a four-year term, is as follows:

- President: Asia-Pacific States
- Vice-Presidents: African States
Eastern European States
Western European and other States
- Rapporteur: Latin American and Caribbean States

19. As is provided for in rule 18 of the rules of procedure, the five members of the Bureau of the Committee of Permanent Representatives will jointly serve as additional vice-presidents of the Bureau of the Assembly.

V. Third open-ended meeting of the Committee of Permanent Representatives to the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

21. Pursuant to rule 23 of the rules of procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly, the Committee of Permanent Representatives, composed of all the permanent representatives of States Members of the United Nations and members of the United Nations specialized agencies that are accredited to UN-Habitat, is to convene twice every four years: once prior to each session of the UN-Habitat Assembly, in preparation for that session, and once for a high-level midterm review.

22. Accordingly, and on the basis of the recommendation of the Bureau of the Committee of Permanent Representatives at its meeting of 2 September 2024, the third open-ended meeting of the Committee of Permanent Representatives is scheduled to take place from 26 to 28 May 2025, immediately prior to the resumed second session of the UN-Habitat Assembly.

23. In line with the recommendation of the Bureau, the third open-ended meeting of the Committee of Permanent Representatives will serve as a preparatory meeting for the resumed second session of the UN-Habitat Assembly and, in addition, will contain elements of a high-level midterm review as part of the efforts to align the planning cycle of UN-Habitat with the quadrennial comprehensive policy review of operational activities for the development of the United Nations system.

24. The provisional agenda for the third open-ended meeting, as recommended by the Bureau, which is set out in document HSP/OECPR.2025/1, is contained in annex II to the present notification.

25. The substantive documents for the meeting will be issued by 14 April 2025, 42 days prior to the start of the meeting, in line with applicable rules of procedure of the UN-Habitat Assembly.
