The Executive Board

The Executive Board

(a) **Implementation of the normative and operational activities of UN-Habitat**

1. *Takes note with appreciation* of the briefing and the report by the Executive Director on normative and operational activities of UN-Habitat⁸, including the way forward for enhanced capacity development across UN-Habitat programmes and *requests* the Executive Director to continue to regularly provide status reports and briefings on UN-Habitat's efforts to assist in the reconstruction of human settlements affected by conflict and disaster.

Draft Decision 2025/C: Update on the implementation of resolutions adopted by the United Nations Habitat Assembly

The Executive Board
