Driving Impact: Outcomes for participants

Post-WUF survey (901 respondents)

- **94%** very satisfied or satisfied
- **94%** very likely or likely to **attend again**
- **74%** of respondents' **perspective on localization changed** after WUF12

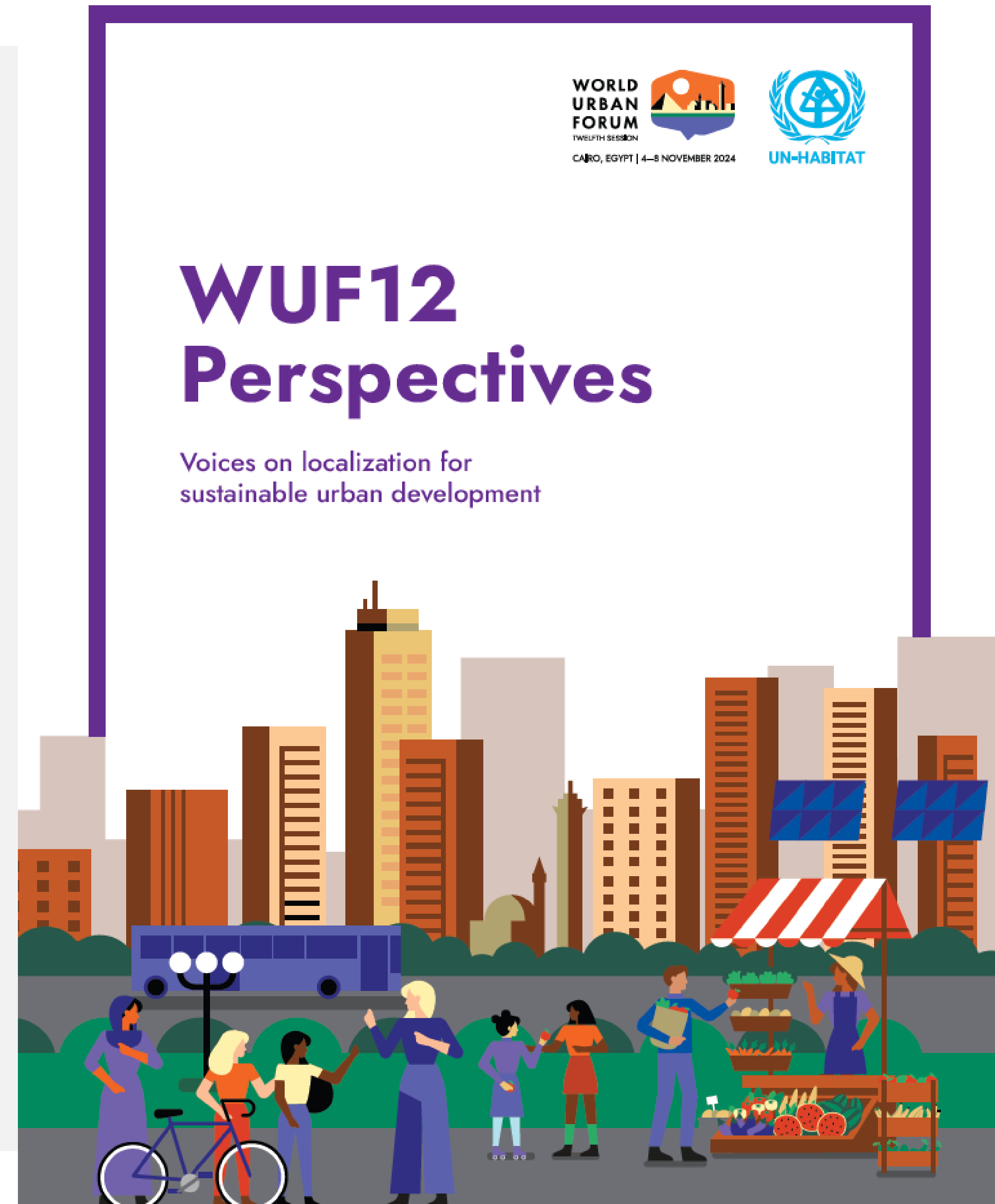

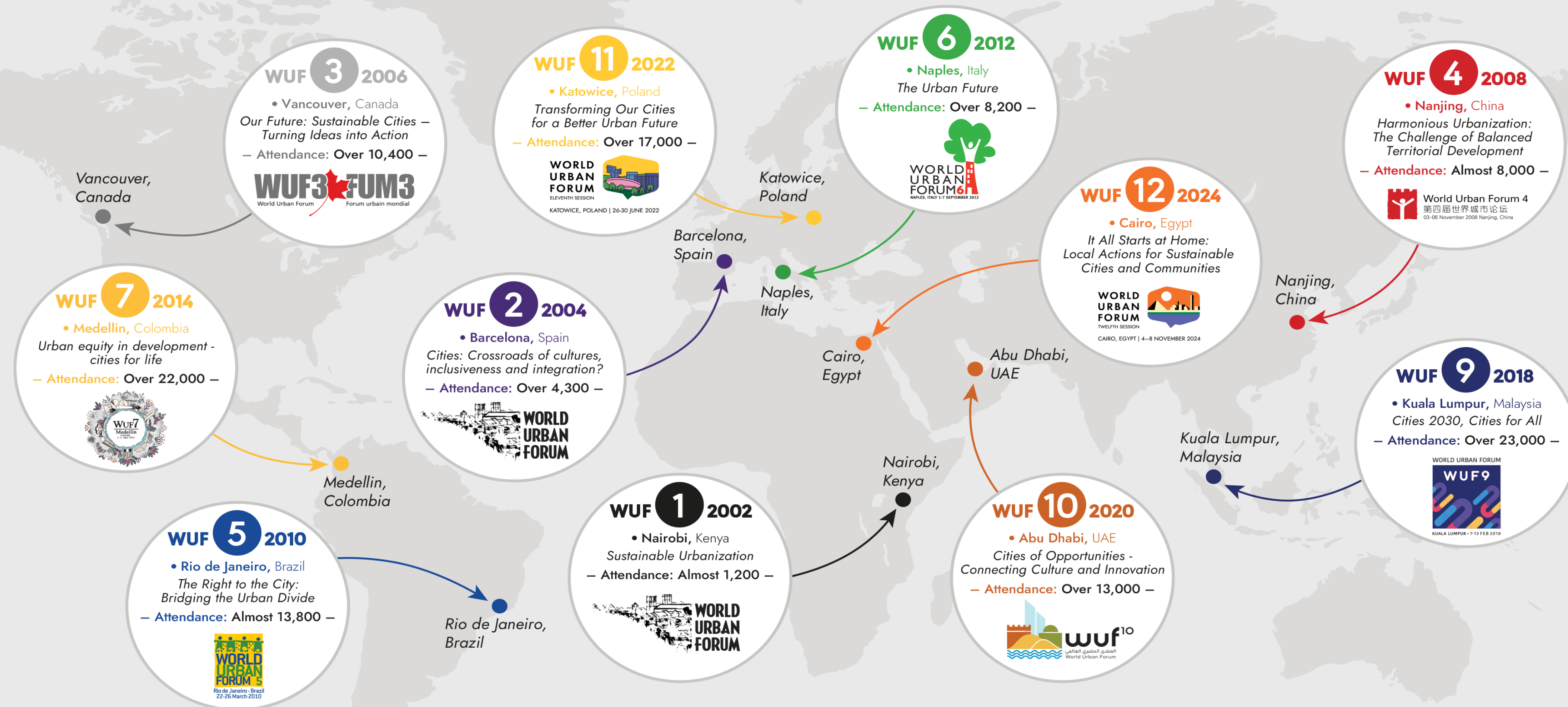

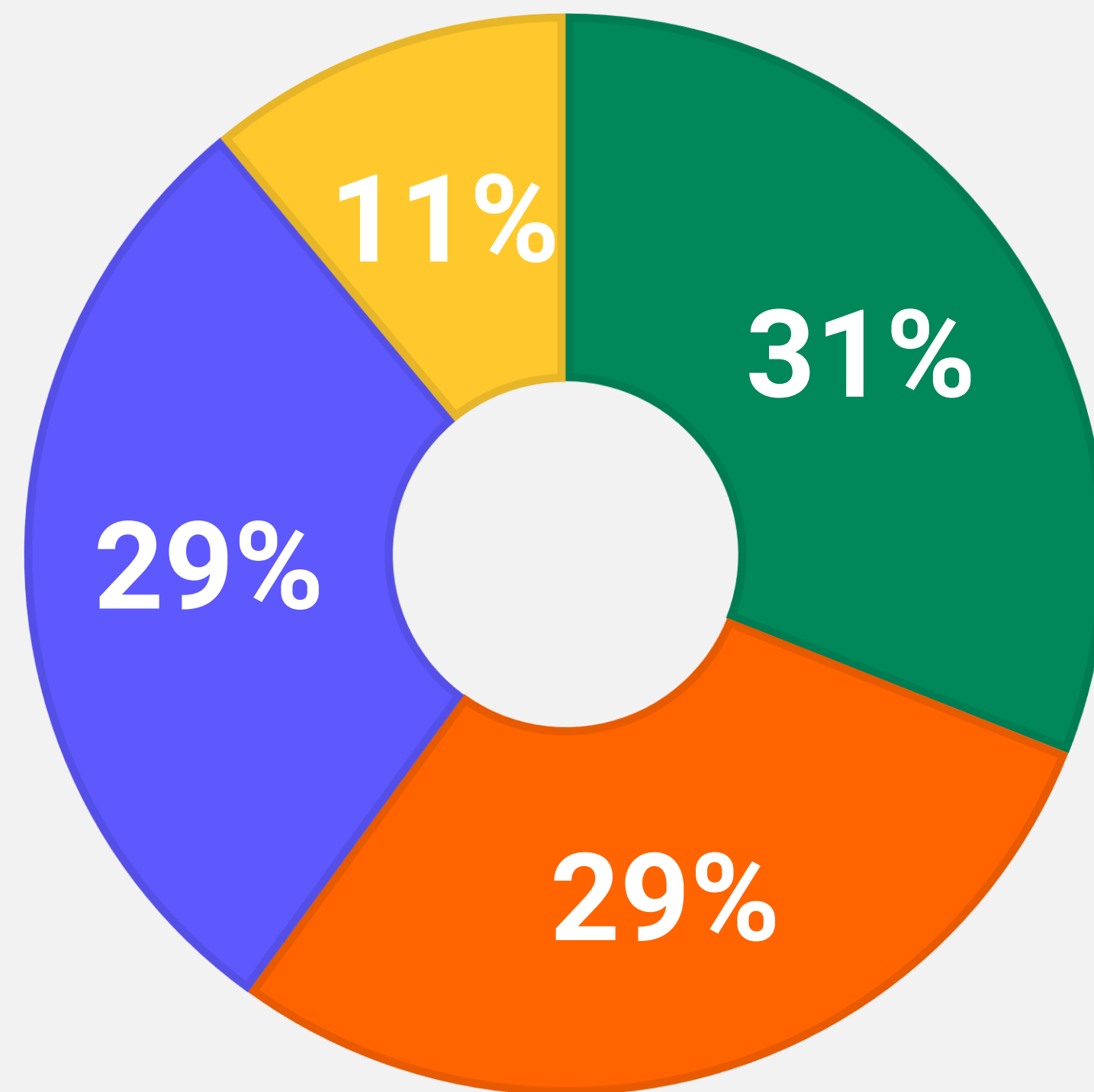
