Thank you, Madam Chair.

We welcome the report of the ED and commend the UN-Habitat for advancing the Platform as an important tool for knowledge-sharing and accountability on SDG 11.

From Egypt's perspective, we believe the Platform can be most effective if it ensures national ownership, regional balance, and multilingual accessibility, as cited in para 10. I hope we could have a clear commitment and a funded plan for a truly multilingual platform, starting with all UN official languages.

Data uploaded should be based on nationally validated sources, reflecting diverse housing realities rather than a one-size-fits-all approach. The idea is not to repeat what we had with other UN platforms.

We also encourage the inclusion of regional knowledge hubs in Africa and the Middle-East, and we stand ready to contribute Egypt's experience, including our smart-city and affordable-housing programmes, as practical examples.

Finally, we recommend that the development of the Platform will be carried out in full respect of national policy space and circumstances.
