The Executive Board

 - the staffing of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme as at 31 December 2025²;

- the update on the Sustainable Cities and Communities Foundation⁴.

[1. (Bis) *Expresses* concern about the net operational deficit of USD 0.4 Million of the Foundation non-earmarked fund, resulting in a decrease of the closing net asset in 2025.]

[1. (Ter) *Requests* the Executive Director to continue efforts towards strengthening non-earmarked and earmarked funding in accordance with the UN-Habitat resource mobilization strategy for the implementation of Strategic Plan 2026–2029, and *invites* all Member States to contribute to the core financial resource of UN-Habitat.]

(b) The status of the draft work programme of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme and the draft budget of the United Nations Habitat and Human Settlements Foundation for 2027

2. *Requests* the ad hoc working group on programmatic, budgetary and administrative matters to continue its consideration of the non-earmarked budget of the United Nations Habitat and Human Settlements Foundation for the year 2027, and *requests* the Executive Director to finalize the draft annual work programme and budget for 2027 based on feedback from the Committee for Programme and Coordination and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, and to present it to the Executive Board at its second session of 2026 for further consideration and possible approval [, taking into account the need to avoid further deficit of the Foundation non-earmarked fund]

(c) Implementation of the strategic plan for the period 2026–2029

3. *Takes note with appreciation* of the report by the Executive Director on the implementation of the strategic plan for UN-Habitat for the period 2026–2029 on:

- Update on the structure and division of responsibilities⁵;
- Baseline values and targets for indicators to be achieved by 2029 of the Monitoring Framework⁶; **Agreed ad ref 1 April 11:36 AM**

4. [*Approves*] [*Welcomes*] the [draft] Resource Mobilization Strategy for the Strategic Plan for the period 2026-2029⁷ [, and requests the Executive Director to present an updated Resource Mobilization Strategy at the second session of the Executive Board in 2026 for possible approval taking into account inputs by the Executive Board;]

5. *Recalls* paragraph 8 of its decision 2025/6, and *takes note* of the information provided by the Executive Director on the implications of the UN80 initiative for the structure, staffing, budgetary planning and work of UN-Habitat, and requests further update at the next Executive Board meeting. **Agreed ad ref 1 April 11:48 AM**

(a) Implementation of the normative and operational activities of UN-Habitat

1. *Welcomes* the briefing and the report by the Executive Director on normative and operational activities of UN-Habitat⁸, including the updates on the Brazil country programme, the Tunisia country programme, the work of the United Nations Innovation Technology Accelerator for Cities (UNITAC) and highlights of activities for the period July-December 2025; **Agreed ad ref 1 April 11:49 AM**

[2. *Takes note of* the revised and updated report⁹ by the Executive Director on the status of the development of the efforts to reconstruct the human settlements in Ukraine [, and request the Executive Director to provide an update in the next session of the Executive Board on the funding status to sustain UN-Habitat presence in Ukraine thereafter April 2026];]

3. *Takes note of* the report by the Executive Director on the status of the development of the efforts to reconstruct the human settlements in the Gaza Strip¹⁰, and requests the Executive Director to complete the comprehensive report once conditions permit; **Agreed ad ref 1 April 11:50 AM**

[3 (bis.) *Reiterates* that reporting by the Executive Director should employ terminology consistent with the relevant mandate of UN-Habitat;]

[3. (Ter.) *Expresses* its support for the ongoing efforts to reconstruct human settlements affected by conflict and disaster and requests the Executive Director to submit regular status reports on all affected regions to the Executive Board in a uniform manner.]

[7 bis *Invites* UN-Habitat, in its capacity as the Secretariat of the process, to explore the possibility with the co-facilitators of ensuring that in the negotiation of the political declaration of the high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the midterm review of the implementation of the New Urban Agenda, due consideration is given to the inclusive participation of Permanent Representatives in New York and Nairobi;]

4. *Decides* that the third session of the Open-Ended Intergovernmental Expert Working Group on Adequate Housing for All, in line with the guidance by the Bureau of the Executive Board. will be held for a duration of two days on 26 and 27 November 2026, and *invites* Member States to consider providing financial resources [to ensure [among other] the [effective] [meaningful] participation of developing countries];
