

DRAIN


Drains prevent our homes

Never let them get blocked.






ROAD






GARBAGE CONTAINER


By throwing our garbage in a container, we will have a clean and healthy city and we will be able to use our streets the right way.





MOSQUITO NET


Mosquitoes transmit malaria and other diseases. Keep them out of the home. Always sleep under a mosquito net at night.

The market can collect rainwater, have garbage containers and provide public toilets. We can even build facilities for disabled people to access the market. Let's all help to keep our markets clean!






BUSH CLEARING

snakes and rats.






BOREHOLE

Never drink river water!






RAIN WATER
